



Tree Harvesting Update – Block F

ACADIA ROAD

Early next week, Musqueam Capital Corporation (MCC) will remove select trees along Acadia Road within the road right-of-way. The work is expected to only take a couple of days. The trees will be removed using best practices and under the strict supervision of environmental experts.

What you can expect

Safety is a priority for MCC. We have a traffic management plan in place and we expect minimal impact on traffic:

- Road crews will be on site to ensure the safety of vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists.
- Work hours will be from 8am to 5pm. **No** street tree removal will be done during school drop-off and pick-up times, which are 8:30am – 9am and 3pm – 3:30pm.

New sidewalk

In July and August, MCC will reconstruct Acadia Street, including adding a sidewalk on the UBC side of the street, where currently one does not exist. More information will be shared in the future.

DELIVERY OF TREES

Next week, trees that were selectively harvested on the Block F site will be delivered to the Musqueam Indian Band for their cultural use. Road crews will manage traffic to ensure safety.

REGULAR COMMUNICATION

MCC will continue to regularly communicate with neighbours about activity on Block F, with an aim to mitigating questions and concerns, while helping people plan for any traffic disruptions.
