# **Update: Metro Vancouver's New Waste-to-Energy Project**

Consultation activities on Metro Vancouver's <a href="new waste-to-energy project">new waste-to-energy project</a> continued in April with a stakeholder workshop for government, First Nations, industry, academic, and non-governmental organization representatives. Attendees were provided information about Metro Vancouver's waste diversion initiatives as well as on the new waste-to-energy project. Following presentations by Board Vice-Chair Raymond Louie and staff, participants provided feedback and participated in discussions about the project.

To date, <u>three sites have been identified</u> by companies proposing to build the new waste-to-energy project (known as the Technology Proponents). Additionally, Metro Vancouver is reviewing submissions from landowners offering sites for purchase or lease. These sites will be announced once option agreements are in place.

An extensive <u>public engagement and consultation program</u>, including community consultations, will be conducted throughout the project. Meetings in communities where potential sites have been identified will occur once all of these sites have all been announced.

#### Caring for the Air 2014

Metro Vancouver released a plain-language report summarizing information about the state of our air quality, as well as the activities carried out each year by Metro Vancouver and partners in the Lower Fraser Valley Airshed to continuously improve our air quality.

Key topics in the 2014 Caring for the Air report include:

- How air quality management programs can prevent health impacts
- Emissions trends and projections for smog-forming pollutants and greenhouse gases
- Air quality in near-roadway environments
- Transportation alternatives, including electric vehicles, active transportation and options for school children
- Next steps for addressing emissions from heavy-duty diesel vehicles
- More improvements in sulphur dioxide levels by updating the ambient air quality objective
- Improvements being made to the air quality monitoring network
- Actions being taken by local governments to address climate change
- The role commercial refrigerants play in climate change


