Section 4.1 of the University Endowment Lands Official Community Plan and the following bylaws establish the rules of eligibility of a candidate for a Design Panelist vacancy on the Advisory Design Panel (or ADP)

Bylaw 11 Advisory Design Panel

11.1 The Board must:

- (a) Appoint Professional ADP Panelists pursuant to the Official Community Plan,
- (b) Appoint a qualified Elector to fill the position of a Neighborhood ADP Panelist when that position is not filled at a Council Election, and
- (c) Appoint a qualified Elector to replace a Neighborhood ADP Panelist who ceases to hold office before the end of that Panelist's term.

11.2 The board may remove a Neighbourhood ADP Panelist for cause, and appoint a qualified Elector to take the place of that person.

11.3 The Board must take such other actions with respect to the Advisory Design Panel as are required of the Council by the Official Community Plan, and the Advisory Design Panel terms of Reference pursuant to the Official Community Plan.

Official Community Plan 4.1 b

UEL resident participation in the Advisory Design Panel:

Two residents from each of the four Area neighborhoods to be elected at the time of the Community Advisory Council elections. These members only participate in the ADP review process only for proposals within their own neighborhoods. Neighborhood Members shall have a two-year term with no limit to the number of terms served subject to removal or replacement at the discretion of the Community Advisory Council. Services will be provided on a volunteer-only (no compensation) basis.

Elector:

An *Elector* is a person who meets ALL the following qualifications:

- Is 18 years of age or older or will be on the voting day;
- Is a Canadian citizen (Note that Landed Immigrants who are not Canadian citizens do not qualify as an *Elector*);
- Has been a resident of British Columbia, as determined in accordance with Section 52 of the *Local Government Act*, for six months immediately preceding voting day;
- Has lived or owned land in the UEL for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; and
- Has not been disqualified by law from voting.

Resident Elector:

In addition to being an Elector, a candidate for the office of Design Panelist is required to be a Resident Elector. A **Resident Elector** is an Elector who resides in the neighbourhood he or she wishes to represent and would have done so for at least 12 months immediately preceding the day of his or her election or appointment.
